The collection of the Tax File Number (TFN) is authorised under Section 128A of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*. Its use and disclosure are strictly regulated by the tax laws, the Privacy Act and the Tax File Number guidelines.

Information supplied to the Department of Veterans' Affairs may be compared with the records of another Agency or body such as:

- the Department of Family and Community Services/Centrelink; and
- the Australian Taxation Office.

It is not an offence if you choose not to supply your Tax File Number, but if you do not, you may not receive any payment from this Department.

You may apply for an exemption if you have a specific physical or mental impairment that prevents you from supplying your Tax File Number.

If you wish to apply for an exemption from providing your Tax File Number, you should contact the Department.
